

Michigan Rural Water Association Wastewater Circuit Rider Position

The Michigan Rural Water Association is hiring a full-time Wastewater Circuit Rider position to provide technical assistance and training to wastewater systems in Michigan. This is a position requiring advanced technical abilities and teaching/consulting capabilities. The position will require extensive travel in the state and several out of state trips per year. A minimum of a Michigan D Wastewater Treatment Certification with experience in wastewater utility management and operations is required, preferably an advanced certification. Computer skills will be necessary, such as Microsoft Office Suite. Seeking candidates who have a good work ethic, are self motivated, and possess excellent communication skills. Dependable transportation and a valid driver's license are required. Mileage is reimbursed at the federal rate or an association provided vehicle. The salary range will be dependent on experience, plus benefits.
