

Attention to those seeking candidacy to the Michigan Rural Water Association Board of Directors

Current policy now allows candidates for the Board of Directors to have their names preprinted on the official MRWA Ballots. In order to have your name appear you must contact the MRWA office by March 11, 2010 and submit the following Questionnaire.

1. Name and member system or corporate partner represented.

2. Why do you want to be on the Board of Directors?

3. What is your background in the municipal/utility field?

4. As a Board Member, there is a significant time commitment required which has an impact on job and family. Do you understand the time commitment necessary, and does your employer support your decision to run for the Board of Directors?

This questionnaire of all candidates will be distributed at the annual meeting to all voters.

Nominations and seconds will be taken from the floor at the annual meeting and write-in candidates will be accepted as in the past.

Remember to contact the MRWA office by March 11, 2010 to have your name printed on the ballot.
